High-powered groups rally behind trolley extension

The little train that could suddenly is the consensus choice for making tracks in downtown Dallas.

Business leaders, city officials and transportation experts are rallying behind the McKinney Avenue Trolley as an alternative source of mass transit in the Central Business District.

There is even talk of seeking federal funds to expand the 4-year-old streetcar operation.

Interest in the trolley's potential has grown as Dallas Area Rapid Transit has backed away from building a special rail system to serve as a "circulator" down-


