## NO MINOR PROBLEM

Green Bay police use undercover stings, meetings before aldermen to crack down on stores selling alcohol to underage customers

A 20-year-old woman standing 5-foot-2 emerges from a convenience store on Green Bay's east side carrying a six-pack of Smirnoff Ice.

Walking around the corner, she approaches a parked van and hands the alcohol over to her partner: Green Bay police officer Mike Francois. The beverages are no longer refreshments or party supplies. They are evidence. And the convenience store is about to get busted.

Francois heads back inside with the six-pack and confronts
