Disheartened and a little angry, Green Bay Packers fans Sunday were left wondering what might have been.

"I'm totally disappointed," said Linda Wheeler, who traveled from California for her first game at Lambeau Field.

Wheeler and thousands of other fans went home dejected after the defending champion Packers fell to the New York Giants 37-20 in a divisional playoff game

that ended Green Bay's season.

Fans were quick to offer different theories for the Packers' lackluster performance, but most agreed that the home team looked bad—really bad.

"We didn't play like the team we were all season," said Chris Lange of Elkhorn. "It's very disappointing."

Several blamed the bye week that Green Bay earned with its impressive 15-1 regular season record. With an extra week to prepare for the playoffs, fans said, the team seemed to have lost

its edge.

"Complacency" was a word being tossed around quite a bit after the final whistle.

Matt Peters, a season ticket holder from Peshtigo, said he saw it with every dropped pass by Green Bay receivers and every defensive failure.

"I don't think they were ready," Peters said.
